OLD BUSINESS:

Agenda Item B: Walking Tour Updates (August 5th and 12th)

The commission discussed where to distribute the booklets in town and regionally. Peer said that she has secured a sandwich board for the August 5th tour but needs one for August 12th. The times for the tours would be 10am to noon. The commission spoke about starting the walking tour at the Panida. The commission said that they would only do the blue tour (downtown). Agenda Item C: Historic Booklet Distribution

The commission discussed the distribution of the booklets and where to leave them. Upton took some to the museum. Garvan said that some will go to the Coeur d'Alene visitor's center. The commission then discussed if the city could somehow participate in the future reprint and funding needed for that. Logan suggested that Albright visit tomorrow's city council meeting with the booklet.

Agenda Item D: Info to include in a potential article in the Bee and Reader about the Walking Tour Booklet

Harp mentioned that a draft of the press release was sent to the Reader but there's no guarantee when it can be published. The commission said they would prefer that the press release be released as soon as possible. Garvan explained that the Bee would like to do an article as well. Harp also mentioned that Sandpoint Online needs to receive the press release as well.

Agenda Item E: Update on the Idaho Heritage Conference

Shea gave an update on the Idaho Heritage Conference and said that he, Albright, Graves, and Hutten would be attending. They would later meet to plan on which sessions to attend in order to get the most out of the conference.
